Montaudon Brut, France NV \$60

Clean and sincere with a flavor of dried fruits and cognac. Finesse, delicacy and subtlety in perfect harmony. The long lasting finish gives further emphasis to its perfect proportions

Asti Spumante, France NV \$23

Wonderful raspberry flavors with subdued bubbles. Light and pleasant and easily drinkable makes for an extremely enjoyable sparkling wine.

Gran Feudo Rosé, Spain \$7/28

100% garnacha tinta from the vineyards in Navarra

Chateau Routas Rouviere Rosé, France \$7.50/30

A refreshing dry rosé from the heart of Provence. Bright red berry and mint aromas with a supple yet dry and crisp finish.

Villa del Borgo Pinot Grigio, Italy 2005 \$7.25/\$27

Estate bottled. Round flavors of buttered pear and almond make this a full-on fruity style.

Alois Lageder Portico dei Leoni Bianco, Italy 2005 \$33

50% Pinot Grigio, 40% Pinot Bianco, 10% Muller Thurgau. Delicious and lovely. Light and crisp with a beautiful, mineral, and lively finish.

Santa Carolina Reserva Sauvignon Blanc, Chile 2006 \$6.50/\$26

Nice, crisp clean fruit with aromas of grapefruit and exotic fruits. Juicy with a long citrus finish.

Giovanni Puiatti Sauvignon Blanc Insonzo, Italy 2005 \$31

Fragrant, intense and wonderfully aromatic. Hints of sage and peach make this wine unique and loaded with personality.

Two Princes Riesling, Germany 2006 \$7.50/\$30

Full of ripe yellow fruit flavors, soft, tasty and beguilingly easy to drink

Piesporter Michelsberg Riesling Spatlese, Germany 2006 \$32

100% Riesling from the steep vineyards of the Mosel. The apple and citrus flavors are balanced with a unique minerality and a crisp acidity.

Cusamano Insolia/Chardonnay, Sicily 2004 \$35

Fantastic, intense and wonderfully aromatic. Hints of sage and peach make this wine unique and loaded with personality.

Dry Creek Chardonnay, California 2004 \$37

Classic California Chardonnay. Aromas of citrus, hazelnut, pear and spice. The citrus nuances and pear make the wine even more enticing.

Featured Red Wines

Colognole Chianti Rufina, Italy 2002 \$9/\$36

A powerful and deeply concentrated, full bodied Chianti. Intense wild cherry and herb flavors and a long, memorable finish..

Dievole Vendemmia Chianti Classico, Italy 2004 \$44

Pleasant, with berry, cherry and light hints of vanilla. Medium-bodied, with fine tannins and a fruity and lively finish.

Zonin Valpolicella Ripasso Superiore, Italy 2006 \$9.50/\$38

70% Corvina, 10% Molinara, 20% Rondinella. Dry on the palate with a fine and harmonious balance, great strength and sturdy body. The after taste is highly persistent and delectably clean.

Mastino Valpolicella Ripasso, Italy 2003 \$42

70% Corvina, 10% Molinara, 20% Rondinella. A deep ruby color with a fragrance of concentrated fruitiness. A rich, dry round taste and a nice and lingering harmonious finish.

Tenuta Sant' Antonio Valpolicella Ripasso Monti Garbi Superiore 2002 \$49

70% Corvina, 10% Croatia and Oseleta, 20% Rondinella. Ruby red color. Cherry and Red fruit give to a soft and enchanting after taste with a hint of spice. Very well balanced.

Vino Nobile di Montepulciano, Italy 2005 \$71

Intense perfumes with both floral and fruit nuances and a well structured palate of full tannins and solid oak on a lingering finish. A true representative of the varietal's deep Tuscan roots

Inama Bradisismo, Italy 2001 \$61

70% Cabernet *Sauvignon*, 20% Carmenere, 10% Merlot. A powerful yet elegant variation on the Bordeaux theme. In which emerged the soft fruit, cocoa and black pepper of the ripe Carmenère balanced with the black cherry of the Cabernet Sauvignon.

Barolo Reserva, Italy 1999 \$81

This wine is deep garnet red with characteristic orange tints which become more apparent as the wine ages. Appealing and very intense aromas of dry roses and violets. On the palate the wine is dry, full, robust and austere, but very velvety and harmonious.

Montgras Reserve Merlot, Chile 2005 \$7.5/\$30

Well-proportioned and solid, with pure cherry and berry characteristics, alongside notes of tobacco and sugar beet. The finish offers mocha and plenty of berry extract.

Kinton Syrah, California \$9.50/\$40

Dense and concentrated, elegant and sleek. Drenched in blackberry and deep blueberry, enriched by hints of fig and spiced with black pepper.

Wakefield Shiraz, Australia \$41

A flavoursome shiraz with ripe berry, spice and plum characters balanced with coffee, mocha and creamy vanillin characters from American oak.

Kenwood Pinot Noir Russian River Valley, California \$40

Fruity floral aromas, wild berry flavors and a smooth finish. Aged in French oak.

Sebastiani Pinot Noir, California 2005 \$9.50/\$40

This is a dark ruby red wine with an Maraschino cherry aroma, rich black cherry flavors which make it jammier and more tannic than past pinot noir vintages

L de Lyeth Cabernet Sauvignon, California 2005 \$7/\$28

Flavors of juicy cherry, mint, herbs, coffee, toasty vanilla and blackberry mingle.

Amberhill Cabernet Sauvignon, California 2002 \$28

Blackberry and cassis, with smooth, velvety tannins. Dry and rich, with a long, fruity finish.

Martin Ray Cabernet Sauvignon Stags Leap, California 2004 \$97

Rich, dark ruby color with soft, ripe fruit forward structure and abundant aromas of plum and black currant. The fruit is integrated with smooth, creamy oak and a wonderful rich lingering finish
